The work to be done under this contract includes the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, tools and all associated work for the following projects as shown on the contract drawings.

Project No. 25MG01 - Parking Lot Modifications
Project No. 22MG02-REBID - Bid Package R - Remote Lots

The work generally includes but is not necessarily limited to the following:

- Curb and parking modifications within the existing long term, extended, and economy parking areas to support the passage of a 40-foot transit bus.
- Construction of concrete islands to support shuttle bus enclosures, with associated curb ramps and modification to parking.
- Erection of shuttle bus enclosures (ACAA procured), including the installation of information display screens, intercom, CCTV, lighting, heaters, benches, refuse receptacles and other customer support amenities.
